Job Action / Bargaining Update

Report cards

The lockout means it is **not** business as usual. Marking and accessing BCeSIS to complete report cards will only be completed during non-lockout hours. It **will not** be possible for teachers to complete report cards in the usual manner or format.

The VSTA is in conversation with the Board to seek agreement on simplified report card formats.

Retirement functions

Functions celebrating members' retirements can continue at off-site locations if planned and funded by teachers. Our VSTA retirement function (planned and funded by the local) will be going ahead.

Retirement functions that are jointly funded by the district and the local and include administrators should not go ahead. They can be postponed to a time when we are no longer in strike action.

Struck work

Districts and government are rescheduling events and activities (provincial exams, report card distribution and filing, routine filing, planning) to earlier in the month to avoid the lockout days in the last week of June. ***This is an attempt to require members to do struck work.*** Teachers are to be reminded to refuse to engage in any struck work activities. This would also extend to any work that may be struck due to an escalation to a full strike.
